

FLYING SCHOOL MEMBERSHIP

You must be a current member of Cabair Flying Schools before you fly with us. New members are required to pay a £50 + VAT joining fee. All members pay an annual membership fee as set out below.

TRIAL LESSONS (AEROPLANES)

THE SINGLETON

The Singleton provides a full 30 minute* 'hands on' introductory training session in a modern aeroplane, complete with a pre-flight briefing from a professional Flying Instructor.

THE LAND AWAY DOUBLE

Experience 2 take-offs and landings and fly the aeroplane yourself! The Land Away Double is designed as a unique double value introduction. It comprises 2 'hands on' 30 minute* training flights with an instructor in one of our modern dual controlled training aircraft.

You fly to another airfield, land and have a coffee with your instructor so you will have the opportunity to ask questions about all aspects of flying. A comprehensive pre-flight briefing and post-flight discussion complete this all inclusive lesson, designed to be 'flying fun' as well as counting towards your Private Pilot Licence.

THE FLYING START

As the name suggests, you really will take off with a flying start! This package provides 5 hours* dual flying training, and although rates of progress will vary, we would expect you to have covered all of the early flight exercises in the syllabus within these sessions. These will include the effects of controls, straight and level flight, climbing, descending and turning.

On completion of The Flying Start, you will have logged 5 hours* towards the minimum 32 hours* flight time required for the issue of your National Private Pilot's Licence. It also includes free Cabair membership and aerodrome fees as well as counting towards your Private Pilot Licence.

TRIAL LESSONS (HELICOPTERS)

30-30 and 60-60

We'll show you the capabilities of the aircraft and explain how they are able to fly in any direction, as well as hover! Your instructor will guide you through the basics of helicopter flight during your lesson, and even let you have a go at hovering on the spot!

We offer two packages: Firstly, the "30/30" lesson which includes 30 minutes* 'hands-on' time plus 30 minutes pre-flight briefing during your one hour package.

Secondly - and even better value - is the "60/60" lesson which includes 60 minutes* 'hands-on' time plus 60 minutes pre-flight briefing during this 2 hour package. Both of our introductory lessons offer 'hands-on' helicopter training and a sample of the challenging world of rotary wing flight. Although the flying controls look similar to those in an aeroplane, there's a world of difference in the handling techniques necessary!

HELI-START HELICOPTER COURSE

Start learning to fly a modern training helicopter with this unique 'hands-on' training package. HELI-Start provides you with 5 hours* of dual flight training towards your PPL(H).

You will cover and practice all of the early flight exercises in the training syllabus within your five, two hour booking sessions. Each 2 hour session normally includes one hour of flying and one hour of briefing. The cost is pre-paid and 'all-inclusive'.

1. Only one 'FLYING START' or 'HELI-START' is available per customer. It includes free membership and aerodrome fees for the course. duration

3. RESTRICTIONS: The following restrictions apply to all participants; a weight limit of 240lbs (17st 2lb) for the Robinson R22 and 300lbs (21st 6lb) for the Robinson R44, and in normal good health. The rotation of the helicopter rotor blades can at times produce a flickering effect, which may pose a hazard to those with epilepsy. Those suffering from an ear infection or common cold may not wish to fly as the change in pressure may damage the ears. We reserve the right to refuse service to anyone that appears to be under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Anyone having consumed drugs or alcohol will not fly. We recognise that certain flights may present difficulties for those with disabilities. Upon booking or purchasing a gift voucher we must be made aware of any disabilities that the recipient may have. BOOKING YOUR LESSON

- Please ensure that adequate time is allowed in order to book your lesson. Weekend days are the busiest times and therefore a longer period of notice maybe required in order to satisfy a specific time, day or date (approx. 2-3 weeks).
- Shorter notice bookings can be made but cannot be guaranteed. If a specific time/day is not important to you and the weather looks fine an 'On the Day' booking may be possible - phone and ask!
- We conduct various types of introductory lesson so please ensure you indicate what type of lesson you expect - or if you have a voucher, what your voucher entitles you to (i.e. 2 or 4 seat, aeroplane or helicopter, 1 or 2 hours lesson).
- You will be asked to bring some identification with you when you come for your lesson. This should be either a passport or photographic driving licence and a copy of a utility bill (telephone, water, gas, electricity). Please ask to speak to the Operations Manager if you are not able to supply an appropriate means of identification.
- For those friends and family that may wish to join you at the airport, you may also use this opportunity to check the various facilities available (cafe, restaurant, bar etc.)

THE DAY OF YOUR LESSON

- Telephone the flying school before leaving home to check that the weather is suitable for your lesson. The weather can look great from the ground but may not be appropriate for your type of flight. Conversely, the weather may not look very good from the ground but may be lovely in the air.
- Remember to bring your two forms of identification - you won't be allowed to fly without them! If you have a gift voucher - make sure you find it and bring it with you.
- Find your camera or camcorder and check it has film and power.
- Flying one of our modern aeroplanes can be likened to driving a car, so no special clothing is required. Wear comfortable clothes - Ladies, high heels are not advisable!
- Plan to arrive 15 minutes before your booking is due to start so that a small amount of paperwork may be completed in plenty of time before your lesson.

ARRIVING AT THE FLYING SCHOOL

- Report to the operations desk where a member of staff will book you in and help you complete your membership form. You will be asked to provide your proofs of identification; these will be copied and attached to your membership form.

Note: Everyone that flies from one of our schools must be a valid member. Membership is included free for the duration of an introductory flight. Finally - Relax: you're going to have a wonderful experience!

MEETING YOUR INSTRUCTOR

- Your instructor will be introduced to you and you will be taken to a briefing area so that he/she can explain the aircraft controls and the basic principles of flight.
- Mention to your instructor if you would like to see a specific town or area from the air. It may not be possible due to airspace restrictions or time considerations but there's no harm in asking!
- Turn off your mobile phone before you get in to the aeroplane.
- Get ready for an experience you won't forget!

OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- **CANCELLATIONS** - Please give as much notice as possible if you need to cancel a booking. A minimum of 24 hours notice is required to cancel a booking without incurring a cancellation fee (£35 + VAT). If a cancellation fee is incurred it will be charged to the account and will need to be paid prior to any subsequent flight.
- **OUT OF DATE VOUCHERS** - Vouchers may be revalidated for a small extra charge:
 - £11.75 for vouchers that have expired by up to 12 months
 - £35.25 for vouchers that have expired in excess of 12 months
- In addition to the revalidation fee, any differential between original and current purchase price would also be required.
- Any cancellation fee previously charged to the account will also require full settlement prior to flight.
